Appointment ended during 1st week of semester	no tuition	no grant	nil
Appointment ended during 2nd to 4th week of semester	25% of tuition	25% of tuition	nil
Appointment ended during 4th to 8th week of semester	50% of tuition	50% of tuition	nil
Appointment ended after 8th week of semester	100% of tuition	50% of tuition	50% of tuition

**(a) 0.25 FTE GA**

Appointment ended during 1st week of semester	no tuition	no grant	nil
Appointment ended during 2nd to 4th week of semester	25% of tuition	12.5% of tuition	12.5% of tuition
Appointment ended during 4th to 8th week of semester	50% of tuition	25% of tuition	25% of tuition
Appointment ended after 8th week of semester	100% of tuition	25% of tuition	75% of tuition

E.g. If a student enrolls for 9 hours in the fall semester and receives a 0.25 FTE research assistantship, based on 2006/07 rates:

1. Tuition charged to account - \$2,639 assistantship grant credited to account - \$1,319.50. Balance paid by student - \$1,319.50.
2. Student withdraws week 7 of the semester.
3. Tuition charge reduced to 50% of original cost - \$1,319.50.
4. Assistantship grant reduced to 25% of original tuition - \$659.75.
5. Refund now due to student - \$659.75.
6. BUT - original payment - \$1,319.50 therefore net cost to student is \$659.75.
